However, after just a lap of Auckland's Bucklands Beach, Dallas was looking very much at home in the skipper's seat, and is looking forward to many adventures over the coming seasons.

The Mac 360 is a great 'first' boat. Its rotationally-moulded, high-impact-resistant plastic construction makes it almost bulletproof, and its design makes it a stable craft. This, combined with the reliability that is an intrinsic part of the Mercury outboard brand, will ensure Dallas and his family have many hours of safe boating ahead of them.
